

## **Volleyball Alberta Provincial Team Coaching Opportunity**

#### 2025 TEAM ALBERTA – 17U INDOOR COACHING POSITIONS

Under the direction of the Manager, High Performance & Leadership, the coaches will facilitate a high-performance environment that promotes learning and growth of our elite athletes from throughout our Province.

Volleyball Alberta is currently seeking qualified individuals for the following positions:

- 1. One Team Alberta Girls' Head Coach (17U) Canada Cup in St. Catherines, Ontario
- 2. One Team Alberta Boy's Head Coach (17U) Canada Cup in St. Catherines, Ontario
- 3. One Assistant Coach PER TEAM

### Coach Role and Responsibilities – (but not limited to):

- Involved in the selection and appointment of assistant coaches. Assistant coach applicants must also submit applications to Volleyball Alberta.
- Team administrative duties.
- Supervision of athletes in residence & training/competition venues throughout the training/competition period (at least one coach/team is expected to stay in residence overnight with the athletes).
- Involvement in athlete identification including advanced scouting at Volleyball Alberta events and conducting talent identification during the months of February June.
  - Regional Identification Camps are scheduled for:
    - March 16<sup>th</sup> for 17U Girls in Lethbridge
    - March 22<sup>nd</sup> for 17U Boys in Lethbridge
  - o Major Centre's Identification Camps are scheduled for:
    - April 5<sup>th</sup> for 17U Girls in Edmonton
    - April 12<sup>th</sup> for 17U Boys in Sylvan Lake
  - Selection Camps are scheduled for:
    - June 7<sup>th</sup> for 17U Girls in Sylvan Lake
    - June 8<sup>th</sup> for 17U Boys in Sylvan Lake
- Review videos submitted by athletes using the video submission analysis through GMTM. This platform will aid in identifying athletes.
- Organization, planning, and execution of summer training schedule in cooperation with Volleyball Alberta high-performance staff and mentor coaches.
  - Team training scheduled for July 6-20<sup>th</sup> in Edmonton.
  - The preparation of your team for the Canada Cup tournament July 21-27<sup>th</sup> in St. Catherines, Ontario.

The coaches will work together alongside mentor coaches to help select a larger group of athletes to attend the Team Alberta Identification Camp and Selection Camp. Athlete Selection Committee Members will work with Team Alberta coaches to select athletes to the competition teams for 2025.



Volleyball Alberta will facilitate a mentorship and professional development program to work with the Team Alberta coaching staff prior to and during the Team Alberta training period. This program will be an opportunity for some of Alberta's most accomplished and most promising coaches to learn from each other and train the Province's top volleyball athletes.

#### **Criteria for Selection:**

- Previous coaching and related age group experience.
- Evidence of advanced technical and tactical knowledge in the sport of volleyball.
- Ability to lead an integrated high-performance training program.
- Previous commitment and contribution to the development of volleyball.
- Excellent communication skills with athletes, coaches, therapist, parents, and administrative staff.
- Commitment to pursue further coaching development and education.
- Performance in a formal interview (if deemed necessary by the Selection Committee).

#### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Head coaches- Advanced Development Certified or Trained with playing experience at the CCAA,
  U Sports, National Team or professional levels.
- Assistant Coaches- Development Coach Certified or Trained with playing experience at the CCAA, U Sports, National team, or professional levels.
- All staff will be required to meet <u>Volleyball Alberta's Person in Authority Requirements.</u>

#### If Selected:

- Must complete the e-Learning NCCP course "Keeping Girls in Sport" (regardless of gender you coach)
- Attend a professional development conference hosted by Volleyball Alberta on June 20- 21<sup>st</sup> 2025 in Calgary.
