Re: Parking Pilot Project at South Campus

Effective October 1, 2020, paid parking will be implemented in select areas of the parking lot located outside of the Saville Community Sports Centre. This pilot project of select paid parking on South Campus, will assist the University of Alberta Parking Services recover costs associated with the parking operation and maintenance of the parking lots on South Campus. These paid spaces will be clearly signed and can only be purchased for a maximum of 4 hours on a weekday. This will help mitigate the use of Park & Ride.

The parking rates will be as follows: \$2.50/2 hours; \$5.00/4 hours; \$10.00 all day on weekends and designated tournament days.

The majority of Lot J (main Saville parking lot), as well as the parking lot at Foote Field will remain free of charge. This would include all accessible parking spaces adjacent to the Saville Community Sports Centre for vehicles with disabled placards. Additional free parking continues to be available evenings and weekends at the adjacent Government of Alberta parking lots.

During COVID if you do happen to have to park at Foote Field or at the Government lots, please be aware that the North entrance doors to the facility are not accessible. Only the South Entrance doors are open for public access.
