

## Volleyball Alberta Opportunity COORDINATOR, HIGH PERFORMANCE

Volleyball Alberta is a not-for-profit organization leading the growth and development of volleyball. The position of Coordinator, High Performance is a contract term position from May 1, 2023 – August 31, 2023, and will be based out of the Edmonton office. The position demands effective administration, organization, communication skills, and the ability to work within a team, including volunteers and staff. The position will be 35 hours/week – weekend work required.

## **Responsibilities:**

- 1. Under the guidance of the Manager, High Performance and Leadership, the successful candidate will be responsible for operating Volleyball Alberta's high-performance programs (Team Alberta). For each of our seven teams, this includes training and preparation for the Canada Cup Tournament (Volleyball Canada event).
  - Organization and execution of team training and pre-competition events, including training schedule, transportation, accommodation, clothing/gear, and other aspects of the program
  - Organize dorm supervision during Training Camps and Team Training
  - Onsite event management at Training Camps, Selections Camps, Team Training, and competitions in St. Catherines, Ontario
  - Organization and support of sports science programming
  - Provide regular communication with participants and coaches
- 2. The Canada Cup tournament will include teams from across Canada and occur in St. Catherines, Ont. at Brock University.
- 3. Inventory and track Volleyball Alberta technology and equipment for Team Alberta programs
- 4. Develop program evaluation tools and collect data
- 5. Other duties:
  - Follow and execute the program budget
  - Update the website with relevant program information
  - Social media content creation
  - Undertake various projects and tasks as assigned
  - Serve as a VA ambassador

Eligibility	As we have applied for funding through the Canada Summer Jobs program, applicants are required to meet the following eligibility requirements:  • Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period  • Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment**; and, have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.  **International students are not eligible participants.
